How To Apply

The Artist ↔ Wilderness ↔ Connection 2005 program is open to all artists working and residing in Montana. Three artists will be chosen to participate in the 2005 program. Applications must post marked by **February 28, 2005**. Notification of accepted and declined applications will be sent by March 21, 2005. For full consideration, please send a packet consisting of the following information. Include four copies of the application and additional requested material, plus the original and a **\$20 application fee**. Only one copy of your work examples and supporting material are required with the original packet. Late applications will not be considered.
