How To Apply

The Artist ↔ Wilderness ↔ Connection 2006 program is open to all artists working and residing in Montana. Up to three artists or artist collaborations will be chosen to participate in the 2007 program. Applications must post marked by **February 28, 2007**. Notification of accepted and declined applications will be sent by March 21, 2007. For full consideration, please send a packet consisting of the following information. Include four copies of the application and additional requested material, plus the original and a **\$20 application fee**. Only one copy of your work examples and supporting material are required with the original packet. If you are applying for a group collaboration, all artists in the collaboration must submit a packet and explain what the collaboration is in the letter of intent. Late applications will not be considered.
