

Hockaday Museum of Art Traveling Medicine Show

The Traveling Medicine Show outreach program is available to schools in Flathead, Lake, and Lincoln counties. While the program is designed to augment fourth and fifth grade curriculum, the scope of art and artifacts is such that it will be of interest to all ages. Presentations last from 1-2½ hours, depending upon school/class requests. When possible, a Blackfeet artist will teach an art project during presentations of more than one hour. Projects will be determined by age of participants and time.

Ideally, a Blackfeet artist will accompany The Traveling Medicine Show for all presentations. However, it may not always be possible for a member of the Blackfeet tribe to be in Kalispell on a scheduled presentation day. In such cases, trained members of the Hockaday Museum Staff will conduct the Medicine Show presentations. A representative of the Museum will accompany The Traveling Medicine Show to all destinations.

A fee of \$100 per day / \$50 for 3 hours or less will be charged to help defray transportation and other costs for The Traveling Medicine Show.

Presentations are offered on Thursdays and Fridays through May, 2007.

Due to the quantity of items and set up time required with the Traveling Medicine Show, we ask that schools designate one location in which all presentations will take place.
