Meet the Museum, Pre-school -1st Grade *Length of tour: 30 minutes (optional 30 minute art activity can be added)*

In this introduction to the museum children learn art media (painting, sculpture, photography), art themes (still life, landscape, portrait), and museum terms (gallery, artist, docent). They will practice good museum manners while exploring the galleries and other rooms in our historic Carnegie building.

Color, Line, and Shape, Grades 1-3 *Length of tour: 45 minutes (optional 45 minute art activity can be added)*

Learn how color, line, and shape are used to make works of art. This tour uses careful looking and discussion to help students understand the basic elements of art.

Exploring the Elements of Art, Grades 4-12 *Length of tour: 45 minutes (45 minute art activity can be added)*

Guided looking, discussion, and activities help students understand how artists consciously manipulate the elements of color, line, shape, form, space, and texture —often in combination—to achieve particular results.

Art & Artists of Montana, Grades 2-12 *Length of tour: 45-60 minutes (45 minute art activity can be added)*

Museum collection pieces are featured on this tour of contemporary and historic art. Featured artists change but may include Winold Reiss, Charlie Russell, O.C. Seltzer, Elizabeth Lochrie, Leonard Lopp, King Kuka, Ace Powell, Mark Ogle, and Linda Tippetts as well as many others. In addition to original sculptures, paintings, and photographs, students may view examples of art used to promote Glacier National Park and Montana tourism.

Current Exhibition Tour, All Grades *Length of tour: 30-45 minutes (optional art activity can be added)*
