

All Manner of Shapes

Shapes are sneaky. Although they can be found in 3-D objects, shapes are only two-dimensional -- they have only length and width. Any time you enclose a space by connecting a line you create a shape. In artworks you can also create them by changes in color, space, or light. Some shapes are geometric and have names such as circle, square, or triangle. Organic shapes are irregular and free-form often suggesting things from the natural world, like plants and animals. This exhibition celebrates all the ways shapes are found in art.

*Pieces selected for display will be determined by how well they represent the theme, the quality of work, and available gallery space. In order to help us create the best collection of art work possible, we ask **teachers** submitting art to **make a pre-selection of entries**.*

Kindergarten through eighth grade **students or their teachers may submit art**. Artwork must have been created August 2020 – February 2021. Limit of one entry per person. **Each work of art should have a title**. Two-dimensional art must be **no larger than 12"x18"**. It is suggested that it be mounted on or matted with colored construction paper; it must be **unframed**. Three-dimensional art will be accepted as exhibit space allows. All **artwork** must be accompanied by a **completed entry form** and **delivered to the Museum** located at 302 Second Avenue East, Kalispell, MT. Entries will be accepted **February 2-23, 2021**.

Artwork must be picked up from the Museum between April 20 and May 1, 2021.
